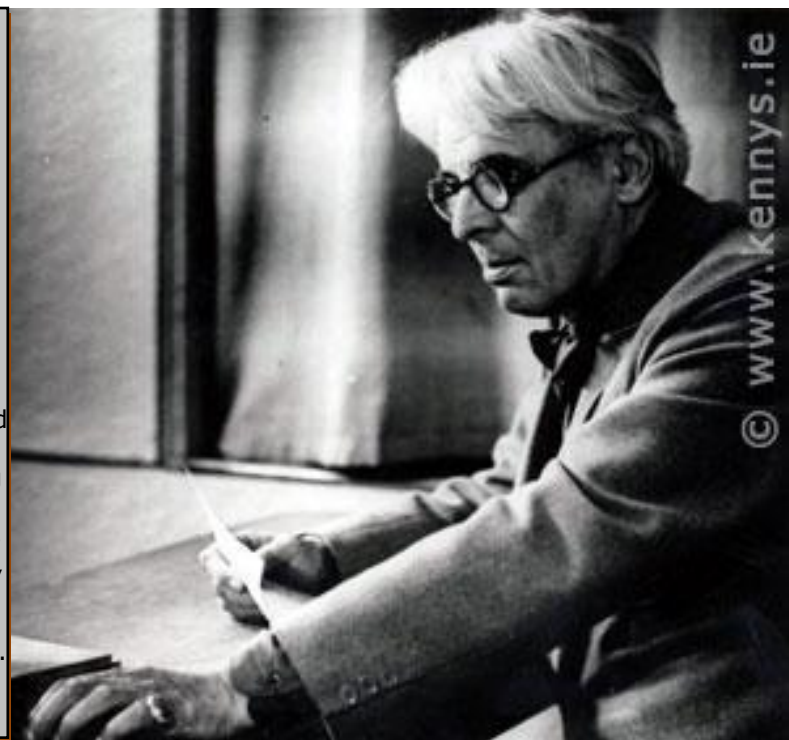

The National Library of Ireland has the largest collection of Yeats manuscripts in the world and, in addition, holds other fascinating Yeats material generously donated by Mrs George Yeats, wife of the poet, and Michael Yeats, the poet's son. The Yeats Collection at the Library includes more than 2000 items, stored in 100 archival boxes, occupying 24 metres of shelf space. In the exhibition, visitors can trace WBY's descent from the conventional Pollexfen and Yeats families, through his unconventional father and his increasingly silent and depressed mother, to WBY and his brother and sisters, who became the single most significant artistic family in twentieth-century Ireland. A computer installation helps visitors get a taste of the worlds of WBY's imagination.

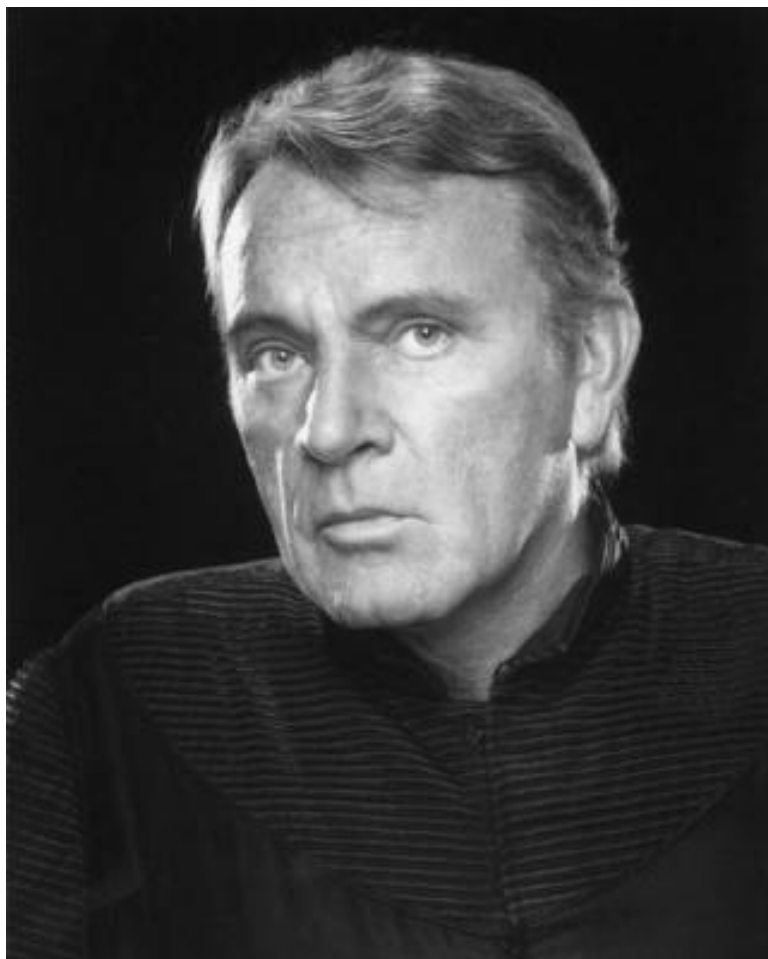

Green Tip of the Week



You can waste up to 4.5 litres of water if you leave the tap running while brushing your teeth - instead, use a glass of water for rinsing, or short bursts from the tap, and you'll only need a fraction of this amount.



Recipe of the Week

Marinated salmon with chilli, lime and honey

Ingredients

2 x 180g/6oz salmon fillet steaks
2.5ml/½ tsp chilli sauce
juice and zest of 1 lime
2.5ml/½ tsp clear honey
ground black pepper
sprigs of fresh coriander

Method

1. Mix together the chilli sauce, honey and the juice and zest of the lime. Stir in plenty of ground black pepper.
2. Pour over the salmon fillets and leave to marinate for 5-10 minutes.
3. Place under a hot grill and cook for 2-3 minutes each side, depending on the thickness of the pieces of fish. They are ready when the salmon becomes opaque all the way through.
4. Serve sprinkled with the fresh coriander on top
